Conditions of Competition

Purpose

The purpose of The Bigley is to have like-minded clubs play against one another in a friendly, yet competitive nature. Invited clubs to come from within the Kansas City metro area and remain closed to the public in all aspects of their operation. Invitations will be extended at the discretion of the Executive Committee.

The Competition

Within each match the two competing teams will be playing ten matches. With the intent to see matches go as close to 18-holes as possible, the matches will be scored in a fashion similar to a Nassau. Each match itself will be worth three points, with one point awarded for the front nine winner, one point for the back nine winner, and one point to the total match winner. In case of ties, points will be split to equal one-half point for each team. Each overall match will be worth thirty points.

Matches will be a combination of singles and fourball matches, handicapped and scratch. In fourball match play, two play their better ball against the better ball of two other players. In the handicap fourball matches, the course handicap of all four players is reduced by the course handicap of the player with the lowest handicap, who then plays from scratch. Each of the other players is allowed

100 percent of the difference. All “members” listed below must be amateur golfers. Seniors must be 50 years of age or older on the day of the match. The match composition will be as followed:

Match #1 – Pro/Pro, Pro/Member, or Member/Member Scratch

Match #2 – Member Singles Scratch

Match #3 – Senior Member Singles Scratch

Match #4 – Net Member/Member Fourball Low (all players below 7.0 index)*

Match #5 – Net Member/Member Fourball Mid (all players between a 5.0 – 11.9 index)*

Match #6 – Net Member/Member Fourball Mid (all players between a 5.0 – 11.9 index)*

Match #7 – Net Member/Member Fourball High (all players above a 10.0 index)*

Match #8 – Net Senior Member/Member Fourball (all players between a 5.0 – 11.9 index)*

Match #9 – Member/Member Fourball Scratch #1

Match #10 – Member/Member Fourball Scratch #2

*In the Net Matches, if a player’s index is above or below the stated index cutoff, but still equates to the course handicap of the stated index parameters, the player is eligible to participate in that match.

Assigned tees for amateur matches will be at the discretion of the host club and will be posted in club profile section. Senior Professionals (50-59 years of age) should play from a tee/yardage roughly 6% less than that of the designated Professional tee. Senior Professionals (60 years of age or older) should play from a tee/yardage roughly 10% less than that of the designated Professional tee. Women Professionals should play from a tee/yardage roughly 15% less than that of the designated Professional tee.

Player Eligibility

- Professionals must be full-time employees of their respective clubs
- All other players must be dues paying members in good standing of their respective clubs and must have an established, active USGA handicap
- Children and/or dependents are not eligible to participate
- Players who have memberships to multiple participating clubs may only play for one club during the designated season
- Should a match be played with an “ineligible” player, that team will forfeit all three match points

Scheduling

Each club will play six matches, a home and away match with each club in their pod, during the regular season. Pods containing three clubs will play two “non-conference” matches against clubs from the other pods of three, as determined by the Executive Committee. Each pod should work together to schedule these matches among one another with the following deadline in mind. It is also strongly encouraged to schedule rain dates for regular season matches.

Regular Season Matches – **must be completed by September 1st**; extensions will not be granted for those teams not scheduling rain dates.

Standings

Pod standings will be available on The Bigley website, www.bigleyinterclub.com.

All standings will be kept by points, not by win/loss records. Host Professionals are responsible for submitting match results to Blake Windsor (blake@shadowglen.org) within 24 hours of the completed match.

The Club within each pod that scores the most points will advance to the semifinals. In the case of a tie, the first tiebreaker will be decided by the head-to-head match of the tied clubs which was won most decisively (on a 30-point overall match basis). If a tie still exists, the total points scored against the third-place team will be the second tiebreaker.

Playoffs

Clubs that win their pod will advance to the semifinals and will be seeded (#1 - #4) based on total points won. Should there be a tie for seeding, total home points won will serve as the first tiebreaker. If a tie still exists, a coin-flip will be used to determine the seeds. Sites and dates for the playoffs will be determined by the Executive Committee and communicated prior to the start of the regular season. Playoff sites will be determined by the following:

Championship Site – the previous year’s winner will host. Should they reach the finals in consecutive years, the runner-up will host. The match will be scheduled from October 1-31, on a date that works best with the host club’s calendar.

Semifinal Sites – teams #3 & #4 from pod 1 will host the semifinal matches. The matches will be scheduled from September 8-30, on a date that works best with the host club’s calendar. Should either of these clubs advance to the playoffs, they will not play at their facility, but at the other site. The #1 overall seed will have preference on their site

Tiebreaker for Semifinal or Championship Match

Should teams be tied at the conclusion of the match, there will be a sudden death playoff. Players from the following matches will proceed to #1 and begin the playoff: Member Singles Scratch, Member/Member Scratch Fourball #1, and Net Member/Member Fourball Low. Handicap strokes will fall as they did in regulation for the Net Member/Member Fourball Low match. The first player/team to win a hole outright will be deemed the winner of that playoff match and awarded one point. The first club to secure two points will win the overall match.

Semifinals Sites for 2023

Semifinal #1 - September 12th @ Shadow Glen; rain date of September 14th

Semifinal #2 - September 26th @ Loch Lloyd; rain date of September 28th

Note - the #1 overall seed will have preference on which date/site their semifinal match against the #4 seed is played at. Should Shadow Glen or Loch Lloyd be the #1 seed, they will not play at their home facility, but at the other site.

Championship Site for 2023

October 10th @ Hallbrook; rain date of October 11th

Should Hallbrook make the championship match, the host site will be CC of Leawood on October 11th (rain date of October 12th)

Each playoff hosting club will be compensated \$1500, which should be used to cover heavy hors d'oeuvres and drinks following the match.

Rules Administration

The Professionals between the competing clubs should work collaboratively to handle any rules disputes. All matches should be played in accordance with the USGA Rules of Golf, with the host club providing a comprehensive overview of any local rules, etc. Each Club Professional is responsible for posting their members' scores as a competition score within 24 hours of the completed match.

Fees

The entry fee for The Bigley Interclub is \$400 per team. The fees will cover the following:

- Website maintenance expenses
- Compensate an Assistant Golf Professional, elected by the Executive Committee, to update and maintain the website
- Compensate each playoff hosting facility \$1500, to be used for F&B and cart fees
- Yearly engraving of the perpetual traveling trophy

Each team has a gentlemen's agreement to provide hors d'oeuvres and beer/cocktails at the conclusion of each match. Food and beverage beyond this agreement will be the responsibility of the participating members.

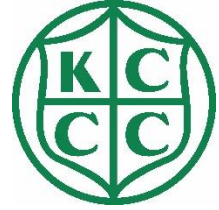
